GYPSON BOARD AND PLASTER

Section - 2512A – USE OF GYPSUM IN SHOWERS AND WATER CLOSETS

Subsection(s) - 2512A

- 1 When gypsum is used as a base for tile or wall panels for tub,
2 shower or water closet compartment walls (see Sections 807.1.2
3 and 807.1.3), water-resistant gypsum backing board *complying*
4 *with ASTM C 630* shall be used. Regular gypsum wallboard is per-
5 mitted under tile or wall panels in other wall and ceiling areas
6 when installed in accordance with Table 25A-G. Water-resistant
7 gypsum board shall not be used in the following locations:

- 9 1. Over a vapor retarder.

 - 11 2. In areas subject to continuous high humidity, such as saunas,
12 steam rooms or gang shower rooms.

 - 14 3. On ceilings where frame spacing exceeds 12 inches (305
15 mm) on center.
